

IMPORTANT WARNING ABOUT USING OUR FLYING FIELD!


When the weather is going through constant freeze and thaw cycles, the flying field is to be considered CLOSED!!!

How about this very early single channel receiver. It was produced by Berkeley Models as their MKIV Aerotrol receiver.

It probably used several deaf aid batteries from early1950s, of 22.5 v, and 3 of them, plus a filament of 1.5v and probably a 4.5 v for the escapement.

Note how large the components are.
