

Improvements to the Flying Field From Arthur Deane, MRCS President



Last weekend, June 16-17, a large pile of crushed asphalt appeared at the entrance to the flying field.

As usual "**Ole Yeller**" bounded to the rescue and with a little help from members spread the material along the two-track into the field.

The ruts from the top of the hill to the turn onto



the race track have all been filled, leveled and rolled.

In addition material has been added to all the spots where water gathers. This should prevent cars bottoming in the ruts and provides a hard surface that will eliminate slipping in the mud. Additional material has also been spread at the road gate to stop erosion.

In recognition for "Ole Yellers" efforts, Jim Lapham was presented with a special engraved pointed shovel recognizing the clubs' appreciation of his special efforts.



(Don't tell Jim, but we gave him his own shovel so that we could get our tools back so we could play in the dirt.)

The club owes **Jim** special appreciation. Without him and "Ole Yeller", this, and many other improvements we have made would not be possible.

aware that horses should not be ridden around the track when planes are in the air.

A meeting was held with the stable operators to ensure that they knew that horse riding on the track past our safety line was not allowed. They were very helpful and said they would conform. Evidence to date indicates they are actively enforcing the rule.

To further reinforce the restriction, a notice has been placed on the track rail at each end of the flight line.
