His Observations, Recommendations and the **tentative** 2023 Activity Calendar are reprinted here.

Survey results : Observations

More members and member participation is a reoccurring theme.

More club activities seems to be one thing the majority, feel they would like to see happen. (Does this seem to focus on fun flies? Possibly? Although the one fun fly held in 2021 only had 6 fliers participating.

Flying with food seems to be a desired activity.

While everyone likes the Midwest field, there is an underlying tone that many feel we pay too much for the field.

Increasing member numbers is both obvious and the seemingly number one priority.

General sport flying is the greatest interest and sailplanes are popular. Are there other event we could have to help increase either of these interests?

Other possible events, maybe center around control line, scale or free flight.

Field updates should focus on tree trimming and cutting of areas impacting takeoff and landing areas.

Also, possible revision to a centralized gathering area around charging station.

Sense that club may need an image update. More accessibility? (Not sure what that means exactly.)

Some interest in club promotional items for club support. (likely to require some more producible art)

Theft of Charging Equipment at the United Flying Organization (UFO) Flying Field

What was missing was 4 of the solar panels, 2000W power inverter, and 4 batteries with all large cables to hook them up. Both sheds were busted open but nothing was obviously missing.



The generator is also missing. And our gas powered ring pot heater (I have no idea what it is actually called).

There is evidence that they carried everything out to the gate. I found some of the wiring next to the gate and an insulator from the wiring next to the rock by the gate.

Most likely the theft was by some one that did not have lock access. Walk from gate to flying site is 1500 feet or better.

Greg Eilers and the other Midwest Officers are discussing this problem and Rick Sawicki is sharing this information with other local clubs.

NCM airframes are mostly constructed from not conventional materials i.e.; sheet foam, foam board, cardboard, block foam, foam insulation material, etc.

Foam Flurry for NCM aircraft: This is a true event. It is based upon the all up/last down event of early electric meets. Any NCM aircraft may be used (no ARF types). Power systems are limited to a maximum of 3S (no paralleling) LiPo batteries or 4S maximum, no paralleling, for A123 packs.
