"After 36 years in business FMA, Inc has made the decision to cease business operations, effective August 31, 2021. Also ceasing operations is the brand Revolectrix.

Started in 1985 by Fred Marks, FMA has proudly served the R/C Hobby Industry for 25 of its 36 years.

The pandemic brought multiple challenges to manufacturing FMA's products in Asia as disruptions in supply chains and multiple delays and staff shortages at our contract manufacturer all contributed to the decision. As owners and officers of FMA, my brother Tim and I are reaching retirement age and looking forward to pursuing other interests.

Over the years we have made many friends in the business. We want to thank all those friends for the support and encouragement. Most of all we want to offer a special thanks to the thousands of customers who have made this family business a joy to operate.

### The Following is Info from Our Event Director, Greg Eliers via email

Here is a quick summary of the fun fly.

The MRCS fun fly was held as planned Thursday Sept. 16th. Approximately 16 attendees showed up with 6 competing flyers and 10 spectators. Three separate tasks we flown by the 6 participants. They were; 1) 4 cone taxi race, 2) roll and loop 7 times, and 3) climb and glide.

The times for events 1 and 2 were added together and the glide portion of event 3 was deducted from the total of events 1 and 2.

The object was to finish with the lowest possible time.

The best time for each event was as follows. 1) Taxi race 66 seconds / Bill Brown, Jr. 2) loop and roll 54 seconds / Dennis Sumner 3) glide 123 seconds / Bill Brown, Jr.

#### Please Note:

1. The mowing schedule is presented as a general mowing guide to help insure that the field is mowed at least once a week.

2. As shown each of the 4 mowing teams usually have a period of 4 weeks between their respective turns to mow, but this is subject to change (see below).

3. The schedule is NOT intended to be an unbending, all encompassing rule that covers every situation.

4. Each Team Captain is empowered to adjust his team's mowing time and day if required due to weather, special events or another reason; he is responsible for

communicating his adjustments to all the members of his team.

5. In case of vacation or a leave of absence, it is the Team Captain's responsibility to swap weeks with another Team Captain.

6. Additional cuttings are at the discretion of the Team Captains.

7. The attached schedule will NOT be modified for any of the changes listed in items 4, 5 or 6.

Wednesday is mowing day (weather permitting) otherwise Thursday before 6 p.m.

<u>Flight Instructors</u>, please consult the mowing schedule and mowing team leader prior to scheduling training sessions to avoid conflicts.
